My memories of growing up in my hometown are vivid. As babies we were wheeled downtown in a buggy to listen to the Saturday night band concert at the corner of 4th and Cedar Street where Dad played the bass drum as long as I can remember. When old enough my sisters and I played in the band also. When Harold Jr. was six years old he played snare drum along side Dad

I remember baby-sitting for Doc and Becky Whetstine with their daughters Nancy and Judy. Sometimes I would bring them to our house and my sisters would join me in entertaining them. Thanks to Shirley Temple, tap dancing was in. Anita, Glenna, Harold, Jr. and I took tap dancing lessons from Bob Titus. We performed at various town events. Marian Henderson played the piano for us. I remember some wonderful "sailor" costumes that we wore.

Playing on the high school basketball team was a fond memory. We had a good team. I graduated from Wilton High School with the class of 1939.

On April 10, 1943, I enlisted in the U.S. WAVES, took my training at Hunter College in New York, and then served at the Naval Air Station in Anacostia, Virginia as Chief Petty Officer. In January 1945 I married Norman Peeks at Baltimore, Maryland. My sister Anita and John Wyatt stood up with us. We were all four in the service at that time. I was honorably discharged in April, 1945 and returned to my hometown, Wilton Junction.

Norman and I owned and operated Peeks' Electric Service until retirement when we sold the business to T&W Electric in 1980. We are the parents of Pam, Melanie, Rick (deceased), Sandra, and Susanne. I have nine lovely grandchildren.

I now reside in Medford, Oregon but my memories and my heart will always be in my hometown of Wilton, Iowa.
